I really want to thank all parents, learners and staff who work with us to make Sunridge a school of excellence. Since 2013 we have grown way beyond the normal - we have moved forward and created facilities and opportunities which are well respected and sought after.

The old saying "tall trees catch the most wind" is true; as with the growth comes the expectations, critics and entitlement. Parents who pass comments as "pavilion coaches" and "touch line" referees' decisions, places a question mark on their involvement in this regard.

A carefully worded question on the feeling of learners about the above "coaches and referee's" revealed that "listen to me" and "do as I say" does not come from the coach. When the children were asked, they were not so sure about having parents next to the field. It is great to have parents next to the field but just be there! Give the team positive support and not individuals is the choice children made. They experience it much more positive than we might think. A meeting with high schools players clearly showed that they do not want their parents next to the field of play - rather let the reasons be. The discussion of players after the game unsettles them the same as at primary school level. Your child loves you and wants to know you are there for them and that you love them back. Let us see the positive side and enjoy the fact that we are blessed with children and that they can participate in sport.

I will always remember my late first team coach, Mr Bennie van der Westhuizen, and more important was the fact that my dad refused to listen to any negative comments. I am sure there were many! Respect for our coach allowed us to achieve good results and even afforded us a provincial toffee or two in the 80's. I must, however, admit that we also lost a few matches and there were bad times but respect always pulled us through. 'Play for each other' is a motto we should instil.

Thanks to the many parents for their positive support, who refrain from shouting instructions, passing comments or discussing other players. Please allow your child to play as the coach has taught him or her - let them make mistakes, encourage them to listen to and respect the coach, practice harder and to definitely enjoy themselves.

When a team is on the winning path it is everyone's team and the opinions flow freely BUT when the team struggles it is the coach who gets the blame. Sometimes the children or some of them get blamed and singled out - this is taboo! I humbly request you to think carefully of what you do or say next to the field of play. We had a laugh at a little girl who paid more attention to her mum on the side line than to the coach and the game. In hindsight it should never have happened.

We are seeing more and more parents ignoring traffic laws around the school we can only request that the laws must please be respected. Integrity is not in our hands nor for us to instill.

'n Versigtig bewoorde vraag oor die gevoel van leerders oor bogenoemde “afrigters en skeidsregters” het onthul dat “luister vir my” en “maak soos ek sê” nie van die afrigter kom nie. Toe kinders gevra is, was hulle nie so positief daaroor om hul ouers langs die veld te hê nie. Dit is goed en wel vir ouers om langs die veld te wees, net solank hulle die stilte handhaaf. Positiewe steun aan die span en nie aan die individu nie, is die keuse wat kinders gemaak het. Hulle ervaar dit baie meer positief as wat mens sou dink. Tydens 'n vergadering met hoërskoolleerders het dit duidelik geblyk dat hulle glad nie hul ouers langs die sportveld wil hê nie – ons sal liever nie die redes noem nie. Die bespreking van spelers ná die wedstryd het hulle ongelukkig gemaak, soos ook op laerskoolvlak. U kinders het u lief en wil net weet dat u daar is vir hulle en hulle ook liefhet. Kom ons sien die positiewe kant raak en geniet die feit dat ons met kinders geseën is en dat hulle aan sport kan deelneem.

Ek dink altyd aan my eertydse eerstespanafrigter, mnr. Bennie van der Westhuizen, en nog meer belangrik was die feit dat my pa geweier het om na enige negatiewe kommentaar te luister. Daar was seker baie daarvan! Respek vir ons afrigter het ons egter in staat gestel om goed te presteer en selfs in die tagtigerjare 'n provinsiale toffie te verower. Ons het egter ook 'n paar wedstryde verloor en daar was moeilike tye, maar respek het vir alles vergoed. “Speel vir mekaar” is 'n leuse wat ons gerus kan toepas.

Baie dankie aan die talle ouers wat hul kinders op 'n positiewe wyse ondersteun, nie instruksies skree nie en ook nie ander spelers bespreek nie. Laat u kind asseblief toe om te speel soos die afrigter hom of haar geleer het, laat hulle foute maak en moedig hulle aan om na die afrigter te luister en hom/haar te respekteer, harder te oefen en die sport met oorgawe te geniet.

Wanneer 'n span op die wenpad is, is dit almal se span en die menings word links en regs gelug, MAAR wanneer die span sukkel, word die skuld voor die deur van die afrigter gelê. Soms word die kinders of sommige kinders geblameer en uitgesonder – en dit is taboe! Ek rig 'n nederige versoek aan mense om mooi te dink oor wat hulle langs die sportveld doen of sê. Ons het gelag oor 'n dogtertjie wat meer aandag aan haar ma langs die kant as aan die afrigter en die wedstryd geskenk het. Agterna beskou moes dit nooit gebeur het nie.

Ons sien alhoemeer dat ouers die verkeersreëls rondom die skool ignoreer en ons kan net versoek dat die wette asseblief gerespekteer moet word. Integriteit is nie in ons hande nie en ook nie vir ons om te vestig nie.
