



Geagte Ouers

Ons moet ons werk na die beste van ons vermoë doen en wanneer ek sien hoe uitstekend ons voormalige leerders vaar en as ek na hul hoërskoolresultate kyk, moet ek ons personeel komplementeer vir die ongelooflike werk wat hulle doen.

Kinders sal altyd kinders wees en daar sal altyd aangeleenthede wees waarvan mense nie hou nie of waaroor hulle kan kla. Die kind by die huis is soms nie die kind wat ons by die skool ken nie. Die dinge wat kinders ons vertel oor wat tuis gebeur, is soms net so vreemd of angswekkend as wat hulle u vertel van wat by die skool gebeur. Daar is drie kante aan elke saak!

Miskien moet ons dus saamstem dat ons soms van mekaar sal verskil, maar dat ons dit met respek moet doen. Dit is 'n uitgemaakte saak dat kinders, ouers, personeel, die bestuur en skool in die algemeen altyd onder bespreking sal wees en dat die negatiewe aspekte die meeste aandag geniet. Hiermee in gedagte daag ek u uit om die beleid te volg wat vir ons personeel geld – hulle moet eers die positiewe aspekte van 'n leerder uitlig voordat hulle enigiets negatief mag noem. Indien hulle dit nie doen nie, moet hulle liever niks sê nie.

Kom ons aanvaar dit as ons uitdaging vir 2022 en pas dit selfs tuis toe. U sal verbaas wees om te sien watter verskil dit maak.

We are here to do our job as best we can and when I see how well our past pupils are doing and I see their high school results, I must complement our staff for the unbelievable work they are doing.
