

Dear Parents

2022 has got off to an exciting start with things almost back to normal and with light at the end of the tunnel.. We embrace it with open arms but at the same time will respect and keep to regulations and guidelines as far as possible.

We take pride in how we govern and manage Sunridge. Our service delivery is highly rated and our academic quality speaks for itself. The Senior Management Team takes pride in the allocation of service delivery by teachers, assistant teachers and students. We take pride in not comparing ourselves to other schools and that we focus on Sunridge and what we do. Results from High Schools and the feedback we get is our "scale" and our past learners are performing and achieving well within expectations. Learners who are excelling and reaching very high standards is surely something we also take great pride in BUT ultimately we choose to look at all learners and not only the cream of the crop. It is here that we show that we deliver a service way beyond the normal.

The success of our teachers, assistant teachers and students is measured differently as during Covid-19 they served way beyond the normal where they were put into academic service delivery with exceptional mentors guiding them to achieve such outstanding success. We deliver support to many learners facing challenges and we undertake to continue that.

With our Departmental staff allocation having been cut by four (4) we are the only school in our immediate area required to facing the unfair ratio of 39.4 learners per teacher. With sound governance and proper management, we are dealing with this sensitive challenge with dignity. It is, however, something parents should take note of as our SGB as governors have indicated that they will be stepping in - we are currently dealing successfully with the situation .

Respect is one of our core values BUT sadly the one value so many are willing to ignore when it suits them. Many parents choose not to read newsletters, they then fail to comply and want to make demands and raise their voices.

Policies and rules are not negotiable and are applicable to all. Rude behaviour will not excuse or change them at all. Let us all agree that we will disagree BUT let us do it with respect and comply with rules and regulations.

It is imperative to drop off learners as quickly as possible to ease traffic and support safety. Parents are not allowed to enter our premises. The learner should enter and immediately walk to his/her class. We still find parents who do not drop learners off in the drop off zones but also get out of their vehicle to do so. This is inconsiderate and you should then rather park further away and walk in to the gate.

Although more difficult, the picking up of learners also needs to be done efficiently so as to support the traffic flow . From 2022 we will no longer have staff to watch learners at the gates. Please arrange with your child where they must wait or alternatively park further away and walk to fetch your child at their allocated gate. Learners not picked up within 15 minutes must, for safety reasons, go to the waiting area. The one way turn gate will then be used to exit when you arrive. This must be an exception to the rule.

Parents will only be allowed on the premises for appointments, parent meetings or as spectators for scheduled matches or events where the relevant control measures are in place.

The free roaming by parents and visitors on the premises is something of the past and in the best interest of safety. Dedicated areas will be demarcated for spectators to attend scheduled matches or events and the rules as gazetted in this regard will be communicated to all parents.

We had an "exception policy" and rules on cell phones which were misused and violated fell under this but for the past two years we have applied the rule and regulation that NO Cell Phones were allowed on the school premises. This will still apply - it was previously communicated that phones have been installed for staff to contact parents if needed or for any emergency. Parents can also contact the school. We will relay any urgent messages and also have radios to communicate with ground and key staff members.

Tuck Shop

The tuckshop is up and running and will also be open in the afternoons. The menu has been upgraded and is up to standard. To provide an accurate and reliable service orders must be placed a day in advance. Monday for Tuesday and so on. The order will be freshly prepared and delivered as in the past. Our new service provider is preparing food on site - their well trained and professional staff start as early as 06:00 every day. Please read the e-mail sent in this regard.

Thank you so much to those parents who support and work with us to keep our children and school safe, well maintained and to provide an environment supportive of teaching and learning. What a sight to welcome all learners back and they look happy, relaxed and excited to be back. We will still face challenges and together we can overcome them. Let us embrace 2022 and make a difference as we move forward.

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Geagte Ouers

2022 skop op 'n opwindende noot af met dinge wat na normaal terugkeer met lig wat aan die einde van die tunnel wink. Ons verwelkom dit met ope arms, maar sal terselfdertyd sover moontlik die riglyne en reëls eerbiedig.

Ons is trots op die manier waarop ons Sunridge beheer en bestuur. Ons dienslewering is uit die boonste rakke en ons akademiese kwaliteit is absoluut uitstaande. Die Senior Bestuursspan is trots op die dienslewering deur onderwysers, assistentonderwysers en studente. Ons roem daarop dat ons nie vergelykings met ander skole tref nie, maar wel op ons eie doen en late by Sunridge fokus. Ons meet onself aan die uitslae by hoërskole en die terugvoer wat ons ontvang, wat duidelik toon dat ons gewese leerlinge volgens verwagting presteer. Ons is beslis trots op daardie leerlinge wat uitblink en hoë standaarde behaal, MAAR aan die einde van die dag is ons trots op alle leerlinge en nie net die room van die oes nie. Dit is hier waar ons bewys dat ons dienslewering ver bo normaal is.

Die sukses van ons onderwysers, assistentonderwysers en studente word verskillend gemeet, aangesien ons dienslewering gedurende Covid-19 ver bo normaal was en besondere sukses op die gebied van akademiese diens onder leiding van buitengewone mentors behaal is. Ons ondersteun talle leerlinge wat uitdagings in die gesig staar en ons sal daarmee volhou.

Ons departementele personeeltoewysing is met vier (4) besnoei, wat beteken ons is die enigste skool in ons onmiddellike omgewing met die onregverdige koers van 39.4 leerlinge per onderwyser. Met sterk leiding en behoorlike bestuur sê ons hierdie sensitiewe uitdaging met waardigheid die stryd aan. Ouers moet egter hiervan kennis neem, aangesien ons SBL as goewerneurs aangedui het dat hulle sal ingryp - die situasie word tans suksesvol hanteer.

Respek is een van ons kernwaardes, MAAR helaas is dit ook die een waardes wat deur talle mense soos 'n lamp aan- en afgeskakel word. Vele ouers kies om nie die nuusbriewe te lees nie, dan eerbiedig hulle nie die reëls nie, gooi eise rond en verhef hul stemme.

Beleide en reëls is ongelukkig ononderhandelbaar en op almal van toepassing. Onbeskofte optrede sal geen verskil maak nie. Kom ons stem saam om te verskil, MAAR kom ons doen dit met respek en met inagneming van die reëls en regulasies.

Dit is noodsaaklik om leerlinge so vinnig moontlik af te laai, want dit bevorder verkeersvloei en veiligheid. Ouers mag ons terrein nie binnekom nie. Die leerling moet binnekom en onmiddellik na sy/haar klas stap. Ons ervaar dat talle ouers nie net hul kinders in die aflaaigebiede aflaai nie, maar uit hul voertuie klim wanneer hulle dit doen. Dit is nie bedagsaam nie en ons versoek dat u liever verder weg parkeer en dan saamstap na die hek toe.

Afhaal van leerlinge moet ook doeltreffend geskied om verkeersvloei te bevorder. Vanaf 2022 het ons nie meer personeel by die hekke beskikbaar wanneer kinders afgehaal word nie. U moet asseblief met u kind reëlings tref oor hoe om buite te wag of u moet verder weg parkeer en na u kind se hek stap. Leerlinge wat nie binne 15 minute gehaal word nie, moet om veiligheidsredes na die wagarea gaan. Die eenrigting-draaihek moet dan gebruik word om die terrein te verlaat wanneer u arriveer. Dit moet die uitsondering op die reël wees.

Ouers word slegs op die terrein toegelaat vir afsprake, ouervergaderings of as toeskouers by wedstryde en ander geleenthede wanneer die betrokke beheermaatreëls in plek geplaas is.

Ouers en besoekers mag, in die belang van veiligheid, nie meer op ons skoolterrein rondwaal nie. Toegewese gebiede sal aan toeskouers beskikbaar gestel word om wedstryde en ander geleenthede by te woon en die reëls soos in die Staatskoerant gepubliseer, sal aan ouers gekommunikeer word.

Daar was 'n "uitsonderingsbeleid" van krag en reëls i.v.m. selfone wat verbuig en oortree is, is hierdeur gedek, maar die reël van GEEN selfone op die skoolterrein is reeds die afgelope twee jaar van krag. Hierdie reël geld steeds en daar is telefone in die skoolgebou vir personeel om ouers te kontak indien nodig, of vir noodgevälle. Ouers kan ook die skool kontak. Dringende boodskappe kan oorgedra word, aangesien ons radio's het om met terreinpersoneel en sleutelpersoneellede te kommunikeer.

Snoepie

Ons snoepie is volspoed aan die gang en is ook in die middag oop. Die spyskaart is bygewerk en op standaard. Om betroubare en akkurate diens te verseker, moet bestellings 'n dag vooruit geplaas word. Maandag vir Dinsdag, ens. Die bestelling sal vars gemaak en afgelewer word, soos in die verlede. Ons nuwe diensverskaffer berei die kos in ons eie snoepie voor en die deeglik opgeleide en professionele personeel begin reeds om 06:00 elke oggend werk. Lees asseblief die e-pos wat ons in hierdie verband gestuur het.

Ons hartlike dank aan daardie ouers wat ons ondersteun en met ons saamwerk om ons kinders en skool veilig en goed versorg te hou en om 'n omgewing te skep wat in die belang van onderrig en onderwys is. Wat 'n voorreg om al die leerlinge terug te verwelkom – hulle lyk gelukkig, ontspanne en opgewonde om terug te wees. Ons sal saam die uitdagings wat oor ons pad kom, trotseer. Ons sien uit na 2022 en sal 'n verskil maak soos ons vorentoe beweeg.
