We are truly blessed with excellent teachers and supportive parents. Working to create the future while facing challenges beyond the normal on all acres. Academic, cultural or sport, in class, on the sport field or on stage. Our thanks to all parents working positively and in harmony with the school, you are the glue keeping all together in the best interest of our children. I salute you all!

The positive overwhelms the negative and the uninformed pessimists need to take note of what our children can achieve.

On the other hand, we battle with a small percentage of negative aspects BUT we also need to address them so that we can prevent children, teachers and parents from falling into this pit.

Kindly take note that we have requested, many times, that parents must please look at their children's exposure to social media and their usage thereof. Sadly, the school gets blamed for these influences as it never comes from home? It is, however, a given that it comes from home, we just don't know which home!

We have successfully overcome the physical clashes and emotional battering before school and during break time. We have always dealt with these matters quite effectively in class. Our discipline, has in general and with the continued support from parents, improved with well over 95% from 2019 to 2022.

A few uninformed comments about "play time" available at school will be dealt with in a full circular at a later date. The fact is that our learners now have more quality "free time" at hand now than ever before and spend much less time sitting. We utilise contact time way more productively while valued social interaction has dramatically improved during school hours.

The only disciplinary issue still causing problems is the **bad language** and **name calling** which aligns itself with what our children are exposed to on social media, DSTV or Netflix. We try to deal with matters respectfully.

The language some children are exposed to does not belong in the vocabulary of these youngsters. They might not know the real meaning but know the words and putting these words and ideas on paper is a trend we have had to deal with over the years. What is worrying is that the learners involved are getting younger. It is not the school's responsibility to instil manners or good discipline - it is a basic behaviour to be taught at home and we respectfully ask that parents take note. Maybe no action is needed now BUT taking note and being alert is way better than getting an unwelcome surprise.

When a parent uses social media or a keyboard to make accusations against the school or a teacher it needs to be done carefully. In the vast majority of cases the information is incorrect and the child is in the wrong or another child caused the issue. Misinformation and ignorance plays a dangerous roll.

Sadly, a "sorry" or apology is a rare outcome and although a small minority it still leaves us with the unsavoury behaviour.

Our children are well sought after by high schools, their academic performance, social skills, leadership and general discipline are pointed out as a strong point. With extra mural activities all over South Africa we get praised for what we achieve as school and as educators. The tremendous feedback and positive outcomes speak for itself.

We need to count our blessings, we are blessed with a good school, good teachers, fantastic parents, talented children, well maintained facilities and resources beyond the norm. Let us work together and deal with the issues threatening our children, our moral responsibility and our future.

Ons Bou die Toekoms: Onderwys Afrika

Sunridge Primêre Skool het die toekenning vir die Beste Suid-Afrikaanse Laerskool-Staaltromorkes ontvang, terwyl ons Marimba-orkes met die tweede en derde pryse in hul kategorieë weggestap het.

Ons is waarlik geseënd met uitstekende onderwysers en ouers wat steunpilare is. Ons bou die toekoms terwyl uitdagings ver bo normaal ons op alle vlakke in die gesig staar – op akademiese, sport- en kultuurgebied, in die klas, op die sportveld of op die verhoog. Ons hartlike dank aan ouers wat op positiewe wyse in harmonie met die skool saamwerk – u is die gom wat alles in die beste belang van ons kinders bymekaar hou. Ek bring hulde aan u!

Die positiewe weeg oorweldigend swaarder as die negatiewe en dit is nou tyd vir die onkundige pessimiste om kennis te neem van watter hoogtes ons kinders kan bereik.

Aan die anderkant voer ons 'n worstelstryd met 'n klein aantal negatiewe aspekte, wat ook ons aandag verg, sodat ons kan help voorkom dat kinders, ouers en onderwysers in hierdie slagtrap.

Ons het reeds herhaalde versoeke aan ouers gerig om kennis te dra van die blootstelling van u kinders aan sosiale media en hoe hulle dit gebruik. Ongelukkig word die skuld vir hierdie invloed voor die skool se deur gelê, want dit kom nooit van die huis af nie! Dit is egter 'n feit dat dit van die huis af kom, ons weet net nie watter huis nie!

Net soos ons fisiese onderonsies en emosionele teistering voor skool en gedurende pouses suksesvol hokgeslaan het, kon ons nog altyd kwessies in die klas suksesvol hanteer. Oor die algemeen het ons dissipline van 2019 tot 2022, met volgehoue hulp van ouers, met ver by 95% verbeter.

Die kommentaar van 'n paar oningeligte ouers oor “speeltyd” by die skool sal op 'n later stadium volledig in 'n omsendbrief aangespreek word. Die feite is dat ons leerders tans meer “vrye tyd” as ooit tot hul beskikking het en heelwat minder sit as tevore. Kontaktyd word baie meer produktief aangewend, terwyl waardevolle sosiale interaksie tydens skoolure drasties verbeter het.

Die enigste kommerwekkende dissiplinêre probleem is **onweloweglike taal** en **mekaar met woorde terg**, wat regstreeks verband hou met dit waaraan ons kinders blootgestel word op sosiale media, DSTV of Netflix. Ons poog om hierdie aangeleentheid met respek te hanteer.

Die taalgebruik waaraan sommige kinders blootgestel word, hoort nie in die woordeskat van jong kinders nie. Hulle verstaan waarskynlik nie die ware betekenis nie, maar hulle ken beslis die woorde! Om hierdie woorde en idees op skrif te stel, is 'n tendens wat die afgelope paar jaar oor ons pad gekom het. Dit is egter kommerwekkend dat die betrokke leerders al hoe jonger raak. Dit is beslis nie die skool se verantwoordelikheid om mooi maniere en goeie dissipline by leerders tuis te bring nie – dit is basiese gedrag wat tuis aangeleer moet word en hierdie aangeleentheid word met respek onder ouers se aandag gebring. Miskien is optrede nie nodig nie, maar dit is heelwat beter om voorbereid te wees as om 'n onwelkome verrassing op die lyf te loop.

Wanneer ouers hulle tot sosiale media of 'n toetsbord wend om die skool of onderwyser te beskuldig, moet dit met omsigtigheid gedoen word, want in die meeste gevalle is dit verkeerde inligting en die kind is verkeerd of 'n ander kind het die probleem veroorsaak. Misleidende inligting en onkunde speel 'n gevaarlike rol.

Ongelukkig word daar selde indien ooit om verskoning gevra, en hoewel dit 'n klein minderheid is, word ons steeds met die onverkwiklike gedrag gelaat.

Ons kinders word met ope arms deur hoërskole verwelkom – daarvoor sorg hul akademiese prestasies, sosiale vaardighede, leierseienskappe en algemene dissipline. By buitemuurse aktiwiteite oor die lengte en breedte van ons land ontvang ons lof vir wat ons as skool en opvoeders vermag het. Die ongelooflike terugvoer en positiewe uitkomstes spreek boekdele.

Ons moet ons seëninge tel – ons is bevoorreg met 'n goeie skool, uitstekende onderwysers, fantastiese ouers, talentvolle kinders, fasiliteite en bronne uit die boonste rakke. Ons moet saamstaan en die kwessies wat ons kinders, ons morele verantwoordelikheid en ons toekoms in gevaar stel, die hoof bied.

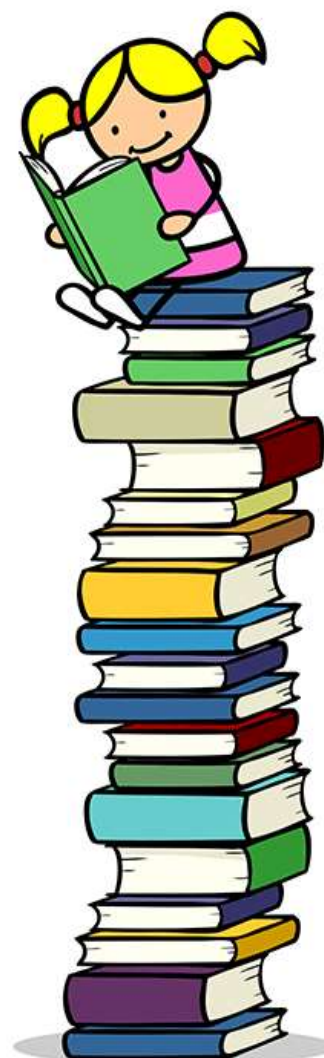
