

Dear Parents

Drop off and Pick Up Zones were created during the pandemic to support parents and have been left in place to be used by parents. We originally manned and managed them as it was expected of us to provide the service. This was done with the majority working with us BUT also with a few who worked against us.

We have left the zones in place even though the measures are now outside of our jurisdiction and control. Parents who park in these zones and prevent other parents from using it now seems to be the order of the day. Definitely not with our consent. We kindly request parents to honour and rely on your integrity to respect this so as to make life easier for the majority.

We have requested the authorities to support us in getting the zones officially recognized as no parking zones and hope this can be done sooner rather than later as we can clearly see the total disrespect for its purpose by some. We as Principals have discussed this and agree it is a common trend happening at all schools. Maybe a side effect from Covid or perhaps the self-entitlement of the current generation?

In **the past** some parents dropped their children off as early as 05:30 and insisted that we open the gates and receive them. The gates were not opened earlier in the past but were unlocked by the support staff at 06:30 so as to get the entire school ready for the day. This was misused by parents who started to see it as a drop-off time. This habit put us at risk as children are not supposed to be on the premises without supervision (this is the law). Our children were not under supervision as staff were only required to be at school at 07:40. Covid-19 clearly exposed this matter and the fact that other schools allow it is not a reason for us to follow.

As management was concerned about this matter staff were requested to be at school at 07:15 (25 minutes earlier). We combine it with academic support to learners, reading time, homework time and admin time in class.

The fact that some children are left at school well beyond the 15 – 30 minute pick up time policy and only being picked up, some even as late as 19:00, presents another huge problem. We do not provide an after care service and the fact that we care about children cannot be misused as is currently being done. We are consulting with the Department of Education and an option being considered is to cancel the registration of frequent misusers.

With parents in need of support, due to challenges, our policy provides for exceptions BUT within what we can deal with and with proper communication. We are aware of parents/ aftercare center's providing a service in this regard. We would like to invite these parents/ aftercare center's to contact the school so that we can give your contact details to parents in need of this type of service.

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Geagte Ouers

Oplaa- en aflaai-areas is gedurende die pandemie geskep om ouers te ondersteun, en in plek gelaat om deur ouers gebruik te word. Oorspronklik is dit deur ons bestuur en beman, aangesien daar van ons verwag was om die diens te lewer. Ons het die samewerking van die meerderheid betrokkenes gehad, MAAR daar was ook 'n paar wat ons in die wiele gery het.

Ons het die areas in plek geplaas, maar dit val nou buite ons jurisdiksie en beheer. Ouers wat in die areas parkeer en ander ouers verhoed om dit te gebruik, is aan die orde van die dag – maar dit geskied sonder ons toestemming. Ons rig 'n vriendelike versoek aan ouers om integriteit aan die dag te lê in hierdie verband – dit maak die lewe makliker vir almal.

Ons het 'n versoek aan die owerhede gerig om hierdie areas so spoedig moontlik amptelik as geen parkering-gebiede verklaar te kry, want dis vir ons duidelik dat daar 'n totale gebrek aan respek vir die doel hiervan by sommige mense heers. Ons as Skoolhoofde stem saam dat hierdie 'n heersende tendens by alle skole is – dalk is dit 'n nagevolg van Covid of miskien die eiegeregtigheid van die huidige generasie?

In die verlede het ouers hul kinders so vroeg as 05:30 afgelaai en het hulle daarop aangedring dat ons die hekke moes oopmaak en die kinders moes ontvang. Die hekke is nie in die verlede vroeër oopgemaak nie, maar is om 06:30 deur die ondersteuningspersoneel oopgesluit terwyl hulle die hele skool gereed gekry het. Ouers het hiervan misbruik gemaak en dit as aflaaityd beskou. Hierdie gewoonte het ons aan risiko's blootgestel, want kinders is nie veronderstel om sonder toesig op die skoolterrein te wees nie (dit is die wet). Ons kinders was nie in die verlede onder toesig nie, want daar was van personeel verwag om eers om 07:40 by die skool te wees. Covid-19 het hierdie saak aan die lig gebring en die feit dat ander skole dit toelaat, beteken nie dat ons hul voorbeeld moet volg nie.

Aangesien die bestuur oor hierdie saak besorgd was, het ons personeel versoek om reeds om 07:15 (25 minute vroeër) by die werk te wees. Ons kon dit dan kombineer met akademiese hulp aan leerders, lees-, huiswerk- en admintyd in die klas.

Nog 'n yslike probleem is die feit dat kinders lank ná die beleid van 15 -30 min afhaaltyd – tot so laat as 19:00 – by die skool gelaat word. Ons bied nie 'n nasorgdiens aan nie en ouers mag nie misbruik maak van die feit dat ons vir kinders omgee nie – wat tans die geval is. Ons is in gesprek met die Onderwysdepartement en 'n opsie wat oorweeg word, is om die registrasie van gereelde wangebruikers te kanselleer.

Ons beleid maak voorsiening vir uitsonderings in die geval van ouers wat a.g.v. uitdagings hulp nodig het – MAAR binne perke en met behoorlike kommunikasie. Ons weet van ouers/sorgsentrums wat 'n diens in hierdie verband lewer. Ons versoek dat hierdie ouers/sorgsentrum die skool kontak sodat ons u besonderhede kan deel met ouers wat hierdie tipe diens benodig.
