

Dear Parents

I apologize if you take offence to the contents of this newsletter but we feel that it is necessary.

During class visits, moving in passages, out on the playground and traveling with our sport teams reveals many aspects I believe we should all take note of. Creating the future is what we seek to achieve and as we focus on providing opportunities we try and stay within our value driven pillars: Respect, Integrity, Compassion and Honesty.

These pillars can easily be manipulated to suit personal agendas BUT with over a thousand children representing 800 odd families a very clear line can be drawn. At school we can create opportunities for children to learn by teaching and delivering the academic curriculum. We teach them to honour our values but the foundation is cast at home.

We all complain about South Africa and the different situations we find ourselves in: from poor service delivery, roads, traffic, crime and many more BUT we miss out the most important part being what is happening on our own doorstep. The entitlement I see in many children is not taught or instilled at school - the disrespect for school rules and policies is our single biggest issue on a daily basis. Many children expect to be served, they cannot serve!

Good manners are replaced by excuses and pure disrespect; this is disguised as the new norm or new way. The blame, however, always falls on other people and the school. Teachers seem to be the new "parents" required to establish basic decency and proper manners while dealing with some adults who lack it.

Requesting a child to please sit down and be quiet when the teacher is teaching is an impossible task and this basic form of discipline and respect comes from home. Children are given rights to such an extent that when we apply our discipline policy we find parents denying their child's behaviour, not taking responsibility and shifting the blame on the teacher. The expectation that the school must teach and instil this parental responsibility while at home it is being neglected, is a threat to our society.

I have previously written to parents re the fact that mum or dad will ask more than once for a child to do something - why? Please come and eat is repeated several times - why?

Then I see how children behave in a group: non-existent table manners and eating habits - shocking, as if knives and forks come from the stone age. Is it the norm now to eat take-aways by hand?

I fail to see that it is now the school's responsibility to teach children the basic values. We cannot instil manners and self-respect either and the few parents trying to get this right fight an uphill battle with us. Thank you for those who try and work daily to instil proper values and manners.

I am a parent and maybe soon a grandparent, this is worrying as this cannot be our future and denying it is being "out of touch" with reality. Please take this as a call for parents to carefully look at what is really happening - how does your child speak to you and to others? Does your child treat you with respect or are you allowing this to happen under your nose?

The real test is what your child is doing when you are not there, not telling you what they are doing BUT what they do! They follow your example and parents who show disrespect to school rules and policies are the foundation for their own children's failure.

Attending school is compulsory and attending it for the full school day/hours also. The mere fact that a parent informs us that their child will be picked up because they are going somewhere or on the way to is in the same category.

You might find that we will refuse to release your child from school - if you do not intend to send your child to school for the full day as shopping, holiday, hunting and who knows what are seemingly more important, rather keep him/her at home. We take over all parental rights when your child enters our premises and will exercise our rights as we see fit - it is more important for your child to attend school and school related activities.

Our policy and the law on school attendance is clear and well communicated.

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Geagte Ouers

Ek vra om verskoning indien u aanstoot neem oor die inhoud van die nuusbrieff, maar ons voel dit is nodig.

Tydens klaskamerbesoeke, terwyl 'n mens in die gange loop, op die speelterrein en op reis met ons sportspanne het ons tot die besef gekom dat daar talle aangeleenthede is wat ons aandag vereis. Ons doelwit is om die toekoms te bou en ons fokus daarop om geleenthede binne ons waardegedrewe pilare te skep: Respek, Integriteit, Deernis en Eerlikheid.

Hierdie pilare kan maklik gemanipuleer word om by persoonlike agendas te pas, MAAR met meer as 1 000 kinders en ongeveer 800 gesinne as deel van ons skool, kan 'n baie duidelike streep getrek word. By die skool kan ons geleenthede vir kinders skep deur hulle te onderrig en die akademiese leerplan te volg, ons kan ons waardes by hulle tuisbring, maar die grondslag word tuis gelê.

Ons raas hard oor Suid-Afrika en die verskillende situasies waarin ons onself bevind, van swak dienslewering, paaie, verkeer, misdaad ensomeer, MAAR die belangrikste aspek word uit die oog verloor – vee eers voor jou eie deur. Die eiegeregtigheid wat ek by talle kinders bespeur, word beslis nie by die skool geleer of ingeskerp nie, die gebrek aan respek vir skoolreëls en beleide is op 'n daaglikse basis ons grootste uitdaging. Talle kinders verwag om bedien te word, maar hulle kan nie dien nie!

Goeie maniere word deur verskonings en suiwer disrespek vervang – dit word as die nuwe norm of nuwe wyse verdoes. Die skuld word altyd op ander mense of die skool gepak. Dit wil voorkom asof onderwysers die nuwe “ouers” is en daar word van hulle verwag om basiese ordentlikheid en mooi maniere tuis te bring, terwyl hulle te doen het met sommige volwassenes by wie dit nie bestaan nie.

Dit is 'n saak van onmoontlikheid om 'n kind te vra om te sit en aandag te skenk terwyl die onderwyser praat – hierdie basiese vorm van dissipline en respek kom van die huis af. Regte word in so 'n mate aan kinders toegeken dat wanneer ons ons dissiplinebeleid toepas, ons ervaar dat ouers hul kind se gedrag ontken, nie verantwoordelikheid aanvaar nie en die onderwyser blameer. Die verwagting dat die skool hierdie basiese verantwoordelikheid vir die kind moet aanleer en inskerp, terwyl dit tuis nagelaat word, bedreig ons samelewing.

Ek het voorheen aan ouers daaroor geskryf dat Mamma en Pappa 'n kind meer as een keer moet vra om iets te doen – waarom? “Kom eet, asseblief,” word 'n paar keer herhaal – waarom?

Dan sien ek hoe kinders in 'n groep optree; tafelmaniere bestaan glad nie en eetgewoontes is skokkend, want dit wil voorkom asof messe en vurke saam met polvyte uit die mode is. Is die norm nou om wegneemetes met die hand te eet? Dit is vir my duister hoe dit nou die skool se verantwoordelikheid geword het om basiese waardes by kinders tuis te bring, ons kan ook nie waagmoed en selfrespek vir kinders leer nie en die enkele ouers wat daardie paadjie probeer stap, sal sukkel om die stryd met ons aan te knoop. Baie dankie aan diegene wat op 'n daaglikse basis hul bes probeer om behoorlike waardes en maniere by hul kinders tuis te bring.

Ek is 'n ouer en miskien binnekort 'n oupa en dit is vir my 'n kwelling des geestes dat hierdie dalk ons voorland is en om dit te ontken, beteken 'n mens is “nie in voeling” met die werklikheid nie. Beskou hierdie brieff asseblief as 'n noodkreet aan ouers om kennis te neem van wat regtig aan die orde van die dag is en hoe u kind met u en ander mense praat. Behandel u kind u met respek, of laat u die teendeel oogluikend toe?

Die ware toets is wat u kind doen wanneer u nie by is nie, om u nie op hoogte te hou van wat hulle doen nie, MAAR wat hulle doen. Hulle volg u voorbeeld en ouers wat die skoolreëls en –beleide verontagsaam, lê die grondslag vir hul kinders se mislukking.

Skoolbywoning is verpligtend, asook bywoning vir die volle skooldag/ure. Die blote feit dat 'n ouer ons in kennis stel dat die kind gehaal sal word want hulle gaan op reis na val in dieselfde kategorie.

U mag vind dat ons sal weier om u kind vroeg te laat gaan, as u nie van plan is om u kind vir die volle dag by die skool te los nie, want u gaan inkopies doen/met vakansie/jag ens. en dit wil voorkom asof dit meer belangrik is, hou hom/haar dan maar eerder tuis.

Aangesien ons die rol van ouer aanvaar wanneer u kind die skoolterrein binnekom, sal ons ons reg uitoefen, aangesien ons dit meer belangrik beskou vir u kind om skool by te woon en aan skoolverwante aktiwiteite deel te neem. Ons beleid en die skoolbywoningswet is duidelik en word deeglik gekommunikeer.
