Dear Parents

We are indeed privileged to be back on the sport fields with our teams competing again on different levels. Staff once again offered up their holiday to tour with our teams: driving busses and taking responsibility. We thank them and the passion in which they serve our children.

We have had good exposure and also competing locally as well as in East London and Makhanda. Driving the bus to Bloemfontein and visiting our teams in Ceres and Paarl also allowed me to measure ourselves on levels beyond our home leagues. Although we might have been found to be too light in some of the heavy weight sections, we stood our ground and returned with respect having been earned and shown to our teams. Apples need to be compared with apples and playing with the big "dogs" asked us to dig deep and show guts. Thank you to the parents who supported and helped us to ensure we completed this exercise successfully.

As always, on a few occasions, the best referees, players and coaches were on the pavilion so nothing new after Covid-19. We need to acknowledge the fact that work needs to be done and with no serious injuries our first step in proper conditioning must be saluted. We will need to spend more hours practising to get back to the level of performance we want to be but must respect and understand that we are working with children.

We are not putting vast amounts of money into sport to achieve results nor are we enrolling players to achieve outcomes. This needs to be acknowledged as here at Sunridge we develop our own children and teams. Thank you for being proud of this and for the unbelievable support from parents and friends. Losing is not an option but it is better to lose against a good team than to win against a weak team.

On the academic side we can report that although we can see the short comings due to Covid-19 we can also see the tremendous improvement. Our language and mathematics averages for the foundation phase is well above the requirements and currently 93% of learners have reached the required outcome - we are working hard to support the other learners. We can report that 99% of the Grade 3's are on track.

With 97% of learners in the intermediate and senior phase fulfilling our Sunridge standards this puts us at 99.4% within the departmental requirement standard. Our support is working and our staff is committed to filling the gaps successfully. It will, however, always require support and understanding from home and hard work still needs to follow over the months to come.

Due to redeployment by the Department we had to bid farewell to Ms Potgieter and Brito at the end of last term. So as to ensure continuity and support to our learners in need we welcome Ms D. Gerber to our didactic department. Due to career changes Ms Leurquain-Steyn will be leaving us and we welcome Mr van Zyl back to our cultural department. He is well known as an old "Sunridger" and has also previously taught here.

Events coming up such as our Amanda Lingenfelder Fast 5 Netball Tournament next Wednesday creates opportunities and spectators are welcome. Come and watch our girls in action and support them.

Personeel het weer hul vakansie opgeoffer om met ons kinders op toer te gaan, die bussies te bestuur en verantwoordelikheid te neem. Baie dankie vir die opoffering en die passie waarmee u in diens van ons kinders staan.

Ons het plaaslik, sowel as in Oos-Londen en Makhanda deelgeneem. Om die bussie na Bloemfontein te bestuur en ons spanne in Ceres en die Paarl te besoek, kon ek eerstehands ervaar hoe ons opweeg teen spanne buite ons tuisliga. Hoewel ons op sommige gebiede nie die mas kon opkom nie, het ons ons goed van ons taak gekwyt en het ons spanne respek verdien. Appels moet tog seker met appels vergelyk word en vir ons om teen die groot manne mee te ding, het waagmoed en uithouvermoë geverg. Baie dankie aan die ouers vir hul ondersteuning en hulp om hierdie waagdrif te trek.

Soos gewoonlik het die beste stuurman by tye aan wal gestaan, met skeidsregters, spelers en afrigters op die pawiljoen, so niks het gedurende Covid-19 verander nie. Ons moet egter in gedagte hou dat daar baie werk voorlê en met geen ernstige beserings wat opgedoen is nie, is die stryd halfpad gewonne. Ons moet beslis meer tyd aan oefening bestee ten einde die gewenste prestasievlak te bereik, maar met respek- ons moet weet en verstaan dat ons met kinders werk.

Ons stort nie sakke vol geld in sport en ons werf nie spelers net om resultate te behaal nie. Dit is belangrik om dit te begryp, want hier by Sunridge ontwikkel ons kinders en spanne. Dankie dat u trots is daarop en vir die ongelooflike ondersteuning wat ons van ouers en vriende ontvang. Om te verloor is nie 'n opsie nie, maar dit is beter om teen 'n goeie span te verloor as teen 'n swak span te wen.

Wat die akademie betref, kan ons die skade sien wat deur Covid-19 aangerig is, maar ons is ook bewus van die ongelooflike vordering wat gemaak is. Ons taal- en wiskundegemiddelde vir die grondslagfase is ver bo die vereistes en met 93% van leerlinge wat die vereiste uitkoms bereik het, werk ons hard aan ons ondersteuning van die enkele ander leerlinge. Ons kan noem dat 99% van Gr 3's op spoed is.

Met 97% van leerders in die intermediêre en senior fase wat aan ons Sunridge-standaarde voldoen, plaas dit ons op 99.4% van die vereiste Departementele standaard. Ons ondersteuning werp vrugte af en ons personeel is daaraan toegewy om al die tekortkominge uit die weg te ruim. Dit sal egter van die ouerhuis se kant begrip en ondersteuning verg en daar lê 'n opdraande pad voor vir die volgende paar maande.

Ons moes van mej. Potgieter en mev. Brito afskeid neem in die naam van herontplooiing deur die Departement, maar om onafgebroke hulp te verseker, het ons mej. D. Gerber in ons ondersteuningsdepartement aangestel. Vanweë loopbaanveranderinge neem ons afskeid van mev. Leurquain-Steyn en verwelkom mnr. H Van Zyl terug in ons kultuurdepartement. Hy is reeds 'n bekende by Sunridge, synde 'n oudleerling en onderwyser wat voorheen by ons gewerk het.

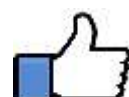
