

Padveiligheid

Hierdie saak is al tot vervelens toe bespreek, maar met talle klagtes oor ouers wat in die straat parkeer, versoek ons weereens dat ouers asseblief die verkeersreëls gehoorsaam en bedagsaamheid teenoor mede-padgebruikers aan die dag lê. Parkeer asseblief weg van die skool en stap nader om u kind te haal – hou die straat oop vir normale verkeersvloei en kom **haal u kind vanaf 'n geparkeerde voertuig. Die skool kan nie 'n wakende oog oor hierdie saak hou nie, MAAR ons kan wangebruik wel aanmeld, aangesien kinders in gevaar gestel word.**

Incidente

Kinders bly steeds kinders en in hierdie gejaagde lewe het ons dikwels by die skool met probleme te kampe. Die kern van die saak is dat ons nooit oorhaastige gevolgtrekkings of aantygings moet maak nie. Ons het hier by die skool tyd nodig om **ondersoek in te stel en agter die kap van die byl te kom. Ons hanteer dit as onderwysers en sal selde 'n verhoor in die teenwoordigheid van ouers aanvra, aangesien dit nie bevorderlik vir jong kinders in 'n laerskoolomgewing is nie.**

Ons kan gewoonlik bewyse insamel en getuies opspoor, maar - selfs meer belangrik – kan ons kinders oorreid om hul foute **te erken. Dit is 'n belangrike stap, want dit is die enigste manier om kinders sover te kry om verantwoordelikheid en aanspreeklikheid vir hul dade te aanvaar.** Indien personeel en ouers nie hierdie standpunt ondersteun nie, dra ons by tot die **generasie van ontkenning, wat nooit iets verkeerd doen nie en altyd 'n sondebok soek.**

U kind moet leer om verantwoordelikheid vir sy eie dade en besluite te neem en ons as volwassenes moet die reëls en regulasies binne ons morele waardes toepas. Monitor u kind se gebruik van sosiale media-platforms asseblief gereeld en lê die uiterste versigtigheid aan die dag wanneer u voor hulle praat en plasings op u eie sosiale media-platform doen.

Baie dankie aan al die ouers wat ons hande vat in hierdie reuse-onderneming, want terwyl u kind oor die volgende paar jaar **volwasse word, sal dit uiters belangrik wees. Die laerskool is steeds 'n vergewensgesinde omgewing waar foute reggestel kan word, maar dit verander jaarliks.**
