The Ever Changing World

The need to justify the behaviour of children has increased over the years. Not much else had changed as children will always be children and they will push the boundaries way beyond our expectations. The fact is, sometimes the child you know at home is not the same child we know at school.

The crux of the matter is we must work together and find the best solutions. Being confronted with problems is a daily exercise which takes an unbelievable amount of manpower BUT finding the solutions is left to just a few!

We need to be informed timeously of any issues. We need to investigate - this is time consuming and we also need to find solutions as soon as possible. Bullying is a broad statement with a very limited meaning.

Bullying is the act of intentionally causing harm to others, through verbal harassment, physical assault, or other more subtle methods of coercion such as manipulation. Bullying can be defined in many different ways. Bullying is usually done to coerce others by fear or threat. Often, bullying is repeated over time. Bullying occurs in rural, suburban, and urban communities, and among children of every income level, race, and geographic region.

Generally agreed that bullying is a subset of aggression: namely aggression that involves

- i) repetition, and
- ii) imbalance of power

Conflict involves antagonism among two or more people. Whereas any two people can have a conflict (or a disagreement or a fight), bullying only occurs where there is a power imbalance - where one child has a hard time defending him or herself. Why is the difference between bullying and conflict important? Conflict resolution or mediation strategies are sometimes misused to solve bullying problems and the other way around.

These strategies can send the message that both children are "partly right and partly wrong," or that, "We need to work out the conflict/bullying between you." These messages are not appropriate messages in cases of bullying (or in any situation where someone is being victimized). The appropriate message to the child who is bullied should be, "Bullying is wrong and no one deserves to be bullied".

President Theodore Roosevelt put it very nicely: "Nobody cares how much you know, until they know how much you care."

At school we take pride in making sure of facts. It is easy to make an accusation BUT it is not that easy to prove it. In 99% of alleged bullying cases at Sunridge the evidence suggests that it is conflict and that the term "Bully" was incorrectly used.

Some learners struggle with social skills (previously communicated) provocation then becomes a reality and the one provoking might get his/her own medicine back. We acknowledge bullying at Sunridge as a reality BUT can categorically state that it is less than 1% while conflict and disrespect is the main reality we must deal with.

Our biggest problem is the branding of the incident as "bullying" creates issues preventing us from acting decisively and successfully. Normal conflict due to a variety of differences is all part of the learning curve.

Let your child report incidents without branding them and give educators enough time to investigate, apply their knowledge and trust them to manage it correctly.

As Principal I have spent the majority of my life in education and I will not be told that a child is guilty without a proper investigation, evidence and without applying fair proactive corrective measures. We cannot allow mediocrity or a half-hearted disciplinary environment without accountability.

Geagte Ouers

Die Winde van Verandering Waai Voortdurend

Die behoefte om ons kinders se gedrag te regverdig, het oor die jare toegeneem. Niks anders het regtig verander nie – kinders sal altyd kinders bly en hulle sal altyd die grense toets, ver bo ons verwagtinge. Die kind wat u by die huis ken, is soms nie die kind wat ons by die skool ken nie – feite.

Die kern van die saak is dat ons moet saamwerk en oplossings vind. Probleme waarmee ons daaglik ge-konfronteer word, verg ongelooflike mannekrag, MAAR wanneer ons oplossings moet vind, is dit dun gesaai!

Ons moet betyds op die hoogte gebring word van probleme, ons moet ondersoek instel - wat tydrowend is - en ons moet so spoedig moontlik oplossings vind. Afknouery is 'n breë stelling met 'n uiters beperkte betekenis.

Afknouery beteken bewustelike benadeling van ander mense, deur verbale teistering, fisiese aanranding of meer subtile metodes van dwang, soos manipulasie. Afknouery kan op baie maniere gedefinieer word. Afknouery vind gewoonlik plaas wanneer ander mense deur vrees of dreigemente onder dwang geplaas word. Dit vind dikwels by herhaling plaas. Afknouery kom in stedelike, voorstedelike en plaasgemeenskappe voor – en onder kinders van elke inkomstegroep, ras en geografiese streek.

Dit is algemeen bekend dat afknouery 'n onderafdeling van aggressie is, naamlik aggressie wat die volgende behels:

- i) herhaling en
- ii) magswanbalans.

Konflik behels antagonisme tussen twee of meer mense. Terwyl enige twee mense in konflik (of 'n meningsverskil of 'n bakleiery) betrokke kan wees, kom afknouery voor waar daar 'n magswanbalans is – waar een van die kinders sukkel om hom- of haarself te verdedig. Waarom is die verskil tussen afknouery en konflik belangrik? Konflik-oplossing of bemiddeling word soms verkeerdlik gebruik om afknouprobleme op te los, en andersom.

Hierdie strategieë kan die boodskap oordra dat albei kinders “deels reg en deels verkeerd” is, of “Ons moet die konflik/afknouery tussen julle oplos”. Hierdie boodskappe is nie toepaslik in gevalle van afknouery nie (of in enige situasie waar iemand die slagoffer is). Die toepaslike boodskap vir die kind wat afgeknou word, is “Afknouery is verkeerd en niemand verdien om afgeknou te word nie”.

President Theodore Roosevelt put it very nicely: “Nobody cares how much you know, until they know how much you care.”

Ons hier by die skool is trots daarop dat ons eers van ons feite seker maak alvorens ons optree. Dit is maklik om beskuldigings rond te slinger, MAAR dit is 'n perd van 'n ander kleur om dit te bewys. In 99% van beweerde gevalle van afknouery by Sunridge, bewys die getuie dat dit in werklikheid konflik is en dat die term “afknouery” verkeerdlik gebruik is.

Leerders worstel met sosiale vaardighede (voorheen aangespreek), dan word uittarting 'n werklikheid en die een wat uittart, kry dalk van sy/haar eie medisyne. Ons besef dat afknouery by Sunridge 'n werklikheid is, MAAR ons kan onomwonde verklaar dat dit minder as 1% van gevalle is, terwyl konflik en gebrek aan respek inderwaarheid die sondebok is.

Ons grootste probleem is dat 'n insident as “afknouery” gebrandmerk word, met gepaardgaande probleme wat ons verhoed om daadwerklik en suksesvol op te tree. Normale konflik as gevolg van allerlei verskille is deel van die gewone leerproses.

Laat u kind insidente aanmeld sonder om 'n etiket daarop te plak, laat die onderwysers genoeg tyd toe om ondersoek in te stel, hulle kennis in te span en vertrou hulle om dit kundig te bestuur.

Ek as Skoolhoof bring die grootste deel van my lewe in die onderwys deur en niemand sal vir my vertel dat 'n kind skuldig is sonder 'n behoorlike ondersoek en bewyse nie en sonder om billike proaktiewe regstellende maatreëls toe te pas nie. Ons kan nie middelmatigheid of 'n halfhartige dissiplinêre omgewing sonder verantwoordbaarheid toelaat nie.
