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Geagte Ouers

Die kwartaal staan einde se kant toe en ons is bly dat ons die toetsreeks binne die tydraamwerk kon aflê. Hoewel beurtkrag ons kniehalter, het ons daarin geslaag om die minimum tyd by die skool te verloor, terwyl die stakingsplanne vir aanstaande week waarskynlik 'n paar klippe in die pad sal rol.

Met die waterkrisis wat soos 'n swaard oor ons hoof hang, is ons bevoorreg dat ons boorgat en tenks ons van water voorsien – MAAR ons kinders moet geleer word om waterwys te wees en sover moontlik water spaarsamig te gebruik. Ons moet steeds op ons knieë bly en bid vir reën – baie boere voer 'n desperate stryd om oorlewing te midde van die heersende droogte, terwyl ons in die stad nie tot dieselfde mate geraak word nie.

Aangesien dissipline tuis begin, is dit vanselfsprekend dat die spaarsamige gebruik van water en elektrisiteit ook tuis begin. Baie dankie aan daardie ouers wat met ons saamwerk en ons ondersteun terwyl ons die wa deur die drif trek. Etiese gedrag is baie vinnig besig om iets van die verlede te word. Allesoorheersend is die siening "Ek het die reg". Hier by die skool kry ons dikwels met hierdie ingesteldheid te doen en ongelukkig nie net by leerders nie, maar ook by volwassenes ('n paar ouers).

Wanneer 'n volwassene (ouer) die skoolreëls verontagsaam, laat dit ons met die dilemma dat kinders vra hoekom hulle dit mag doen! Hoe beantwoord 'n mens hierdie vraag sonder om die volwassene (ouer) in 'n slegte lig te stel? Dit ondermyn respek, etiese gedrag en waardes. Moet ons dan nie maar hande in die lug gooi nie? Sal ons maar die handdoek ingooi en deel word van die anargie wat reeds ons samelewing bedreig? Nee, ons by Sunridge kan dit nooit aanvaar nie – ons sal opstaan en weerstand bied. Ons kan nie ons **WAARDES INBOET** nie en is so dankbaar teenoor daardie ouers wat dieselfde hieroor voel.

Help ons asseblief om ons skool se waardes te ondersteun deur die skoolreëls te gehoorsaam en te respekteer. Dit is wel so dat ons nie almal met die reëls en beleide saamstem of daarvan hou nie, MAAR dit gee ons nie die reg om die reëls te verontagsaam of te buig soos dit ons pas nie.

Iets kleins soos om 'n sportsak of iets deur die skoolheining aan te gee, is teen die reëls en stel al ons kinders in gevaar. Ons sekretaresses is nie afleweringbodes nie. Dit is wel so dat kinders soms van hul besittings by die huis of in die motor sal vergeet, maar dan leer hulle 'n waardevolle les – verantwoordelikheid en aanspreeklikheid. Ons as ouers leer ook 'n paar waardevolle lesse, onder andere dat ons nie die lewenstorms namens ons kinders kan trotseer nie. Daardie veldslag wat 'n mens dink jy gewen het, gaan jou in die toekoms duur te staan kom. Laat jou kind toe om foute te maak, die gevolge te dra en verantwoordelike landsburgers te word wat aanspreeklikheid aanvaar.

Toe 'n Gr 1-leerder 'n senior personeellid voorkeer oor iets wat hy verkeerd gedoen het, was die persoon se eerste reaksie om sy posisie as verskoning te gebruik. Aanspreeklikheid en etiese gedrag het egter ingeskop en die personeellid het die Gr 1-leerder om verskoning gevra en belowe om dit onmiddellik reg te stel. Dit is leierskap, dit toon respek, dit is integriteit en daarvoor sal ons tot die bitter einde veg.
