Baie dankie aan die ouers wat ons in hierdie verband ondersteun – JA, ‘n liter of twee brandstof is altyd welkom, want ‘n kragopwekker verbruik ‘n groot bedrag geld gedurende ‘n sessie van twee ure. Die watertenks wat ons geïnstalleer het en die prefek-inisiatief stel ons kinders in staat om toilette te gebruik en water beskikbaar te hê. Ligte, projektors en interaktiewe witborde kan gebruik word en die snoepie lewer ‘n uitstekende diens – stof tot nadenke.

Die vooringang word tans opgeknep en hierdie prefek-inisiatief van 2022 gaan beslis ‘n groot verskil maak.
