Cancellation of Sport

1. Definitely not the easiest task to predict what the weather will do or what others schools will decide. Within our policy we normally make a decision at 12:30 for Grades 1 & 2 and at 13:00 for Grades 3 - 7. With a sudden weather change it may be close to or even after school closes. This, however, does not then require the child to be fetched at normal closing time - it allows for those who can, to do so. This also helps parents who wish to support matches or need to bring clothing, food etc.
2. The coach or class teacher takes learners who are not picked up back to his/her class until the time they should finish sport. He/she then releases them and normal rules and policies then apply.

This gets communicated frequently and for Grade 1 the communication was all part of their first meeting with the class teachers. This has been the standard practice for years with a very high success rate and well respected. It is shocking when parents jump on a social media platform and take out other parents and the school based on their misinformed position - ignorance is not an excuse.

Cell Phones

The school policy is simple - no cell phones at school. Parents and learners have disregarded and abused this policy for various reasons and with various excuses. The policy is clearly set out in the homework book and has been in force for 10 years. Only learners with medical conditions in need of contact are allowed to use the device for their medical support.

We tried an exception to the rule by allowing applications to be made to have a phone at school - switched off and not to be used on the school premises. We included consequences for learners who transgressed. It has become an overwhelming task and at the end of the day the school and teachers have to pay the price.

Children breaking rules, misuse of cell phones, parents not following the rules and many more. We stopped it in 2020 only to start the battle again now. Please consult your child's homework diary for the rules - they are very clear.

Keep in mind that a cell phone is registered in the name of an adult and the adult is responsible for the phone and all the activities that come with it. We work with and educate children and should we ever again be confronted with any illegal and adult material (on a cell phone or in possession of a child) we will call in the authorities help. This applies to all social media platforms including bullying, foul language, pornography, harassments, racism, violence etc. These are the problems we are confronted with as a result of children being allowed to use cell phones and social media unsupervised. We cannot supervise or accept responsibility or accountability for this.

Cell Phones are forbidden on our school premises if not in the possession of the owner - a responsible and accountable person.

Kansellering van Sport

1. Dit is ‘n tameletjie om te probeer voorspel wat die weer gaan doen of watter besluite ander skole gaan neem. Ingevolge ons beleid neem ons gewoonlik die besluit om 12:30 vir Gr 1 en 2 en om 13:00 vir Gr 3 – 7. Indien die weer onverwags verander, kan dit selfs naby aan huistoegaantyd of daarna wees. Dit beteken egter nie dat die kind onmiddellik gehaal moet word nie, dit is van toepassing op diegene wat daartoe in staat is om dit te doen. Dit is ook ter ondersteuning van ouers wat wedstryde wil bywoon of wat klere, kos of drinkgoed moet bring.
2. Die afrigter of klasonderwyser neem die kinders na sy/haar klas toe indien hulle nie gehaal word nie en hulle bly daar tot tyd en wyl hulle ná sport sou huis toe gaan. Hy/sy word dan verdaag en gewone reëls en beleide is van krag.

Hierdie inligting word gereeld gedeel en vir Gr 1 was dié kommunikasie deel van hul eerste vergadering met die klasonderwyseresse. Hierdie reël is al vir baie jare standaard praktyk en dit is uiters suksesvol en word gerespekteer. Dit is skokkend dat ouers op sosiale media-platforms teen die skool en ander ouers te velde trek, gebaseer op hul onkunde in hierdie verband. Onkunde is beslis geen verskoning nie.

Selfone

Die beleid van die skool is eenvoudig – geen selfone by die skool nie. Ouers en leerders het hierdie beleid om verskillende redes en met verskeie verskonings verontagsaam en misbruik. Die beleid word duidelik in die huiswerkboek uiteengesit en is reeds vir 10 jaar van krag. Slegs leerders met mediese probleme mag selfone by die skool hê vir mediese ondersteuning.

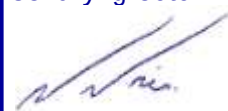
Ons het probeer om uitsonderings toe te laat wanneer daarom aansoek gedoen word, sodat leerders hul fone by die skool kon hê met die selfone afgeskakel en nie op die skoolterrein in gebruik nie. Dit het ‘n oorweldigende taak geword en aan die einde van die dag moet die skool en onderwysers die gelag betaal.

Kinders wat reëls oortree, misbruik van selfone, ouers wat hulle nie aan die reëls steur nie en vele meer. Ons het in 2020 halt geroep, net om nou weer die stryd aan te knoop. Raadpleeg asseblief u kind se huiswerkboek vir die reëls – dit word duidelik uiteengesit.

Hou asseblief in gedagte dat die selfoon in ‘n volwassene se naam geregistreer is en die volwassene is verantwoordelik vir die foon en al die aktiwiteite wat daarmee gepaard gaan. Ons werk met kinders, ons onderrig kinders en indien ons ooit weer te doen kry met onwettige, volwasse gegewens (op ‘n selfoon of in die besit van ‘n kind), sal ons die owerhede se hulp inroep. Dit geld vir alle sosiale media-platforms en behels afknouery, onweloweglike taal, pornografie, teistering, rassisme, geweld, ens. Hierdie is die probleme waarmee ons te kampe het wanneer kinders toegelaat word om selfone en sosiale media sonder toesig te gebruik. Ons kan nie hieroor toesig hou nie en kan ook nie verantwoordelikheid of aanspreeklikheid aanvaar nie.

Selfone word op ons skoolterrein verbied indien dit nie in die besit van die eienaar – die verantwoordelike en aanspreeklike persoon – is nie.

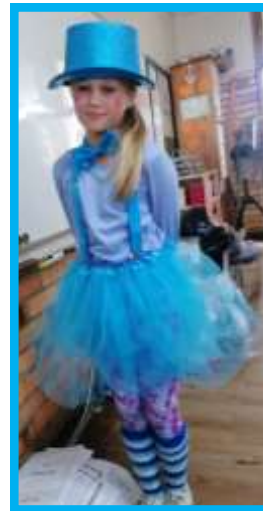
