Grade R 2025

As we still await clarity on the Grade R inclusion as in the Bela Bill, we will continue with our own Grade R policy for 2025. We recommend that all interested parents enroll their children at Sunridge Primary School for Gr R.

You complete a normal Sunridge Primary School application form and hand it in as soon as possible. We will apply our admission policy and if your application is successful, you can apply for admission to one of our service providers or your own/current Gr R service provider.

A nominal fee will be payable to Sunridge Primary School while the cost of the Gr R service is owed directly by you as a parent to your service provider.

Learners who are successfully enrolled at Sunridge Primary School Gr R will be entered and placed on our database and we will serve them as learners of Sunridge Primary School.

Curriculum Matters

We pride ourselves on our high standard of curriculum delivery and with teachers who specialize in subjects and methods of teaching all learners, our standard has continued to improve over the past 12 years. Although we follow the same curriculum as other schools, we focus on improving our assessment standard and all our tests and examinations are set to an extremely high standard, with attention to cognitive levels and comprehensive moderation to ensure quality.

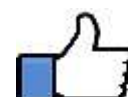
