Met die besluite wat goedgekeur en bekragtig is, sal die skoolfooie R1 800 per maand oor 12 maande wees, betaalbaar op of voor die 7de van elke maand, van Januarie tot Desember.

Dit sluit die boekfooi van R2 760 per jaar in. Aangesien ons alle boeke voor die begin van die jaar aankoop, is die eerste skoolfooiopaaient teen 7 Januarie 2025 betaalbaar – soos ooreengekom en goedgekeur.

Musiekfooi is R460 vir blokfluit en klavier per kwartaal, R575 per instrument per kwartaal en die huurgeld is R375 per instrument per kwartaal.

With the resolutions approved and ratified the school fees will be R1800 per month over 12 months paid on or before the 7th of each month from January to December.

This includes the book fee of R2760 per year. As we buy the books before the start the year, the first school fee payment should be made by 7 January 2025, as agreed upon and approved.

Music fees are R460 for recorder and piano per term, R575 per instrument per term and the hire fee per instrument is R375 per term.
