#### School Attendance

The only valid excuse for not attending school is a medical reason. On this matter silence would be the best option!

Although we should address this newsletter to the 10% minority of our parents absenteeism influences every learner as it puts pressure on the staff and learners who are present.

This is a serious matter as with over a thousand learners we find parents neglect to send their children to school - children are kept at home and extracurricular activities take precedence over school attendance. Children get fetched for a variety of appointments and seemingly the medical profession only sees children during school hours?

Some parents take their children out for breakfast on the last day of school and then arrive at the office, with their children, to collect their reports. Other parents just inform the school that someone will collect the report - this exception was not offered and this was made clear in the newsletter.

The exception to the rule has now become the rule for quite a few parents and the misuse and entitlement together with rudeness is the reason this was not offered at the end of last term. We, however, have allowed it for those learners and parents with a valid medical reason. We apologize for the inconvenience caused to those in real need.

Children get dropped off at school as early as 06:00 and are sometimes only picked up as late as 19:00. We offer assistance for early drop off at 06:30 if requested but not by demand and rude behaviour!

We do not offer a service for late pickups - parents who leave children at school for longer than 30 minutes will, as from this term, be reported to child welfare. We understand that from time to time a problem can arise and will exercise reasonable tolerance before contacting the welfare.

We welcome, respect and love our grandparents but we will not tolerate their disrespect and verbal abuse. Again, so many people support us and show respect, integrity, compassion and honesty that the few who do not need to change their mind-set.

May the Lord bless and protect us.



**Toegewyde personeel en leerders sal altyd 'n wenspan wees. Danksy die ondersteuning van ons ouers, is ons slaggereed vir die toekoms. Kom ons takel die uitdagings van die lewe met oorgawe en laat ons morele waardes rotsvas staan. Integriteit is 'n hoeksteen wat deur eiegerigheid bedreig word en deur 'n gebrek aan toerekenbaarheid ondermy word. Pappa, die manier wat jy jou vrou en die vroue in jou lewe behandel, is 'n etiese aangeleentheid. Mammas verdien respek, want hulle is deel van die hoeksteen van ons samelewing.**

### Skoolbywoning

Die enigste grondige rede om nie skool by te woon nie, is as dit medies van aard is. Oor hierdie aangeleentheid moet die stelswee liewer bewaar word!

Hierdie nuusbrief spreek eintlik tot die minderheid van 10% van ons ouers - die afwesigheid van elke leerder plaas druk op personeel en die leerders wat wel teenwoordig is.

**Hierdie is 'n ernstige aangeleentheid, want ons ondervind dat met meer as eenduisend leerders, ouers nalaat om hul kinders skool toe te stuur. Kinders word goedsmoeds by die huis gehou en buitemuurse aktiwiteite voer die bosoontoor oor skoolbywoning.**

**Kinders word vir 'n magdom afsprake gehaal en dit wil voorkom asof mense in die mediese beroep kinders slegs gedurende skoolure kan spreek!**

Ouers neem hul kinders uit vir ontbyt op die laaste skooldag en daag dan met hul kinders by die kantoor op om die rapport te kom afhaal. Ander ouers sal die skool eenvoudig in kennis stel dat iemand die rapport sal kom afhaal - terwyl die uitsondering nie gemaak is nie – die nuusbrief stel dit baie duidelik.

Die uitsondering op die reël het nou vir baie ouers die reël geword – die vergunning word misbruik en eiegerigheid gepaard met suiwer onbeskoftheid was die rede waarom die uitsondering nie aan die einde van verlede kwartaal aangebied is nie. **Ons het dit egter toegelaat vir leerders en ouers met 'n grondige mediese rede. Ons vra om verskoning aan diegene wat werklik in die nood was.**

Kinders word so vroeg as 06:00 by die skool afgelaai en word soms eers om 19:00 gehaal. Ons bied ondersteuning vir vroeë aflaai om 06:30 indien versoek – maar beslis nie as daar eise gestel word en die gedrag veel te wense oorlaat nie!

**Ons bied nie 'n diens vir kinders wat laat gehaal word nie en ouers wat hul kinders vir langer as 30 minute by die skool los, sal vanaf hierdie kwartaal by Kinderwelsyn aangemeld word. Ons weet dat daar van tyd tot tyd 'n probleem kan opduik en ons het begrip daarvoor. Ons sal billike verdraagsaamheid aan die dag lê voordat ons die welsyn kontak.**

**Ons verwelkom, respekteer en is lief vir ons grootouers, maar ons sal nie 'n gebrek aan respek en mondelinge beledigings toelaat nie. Weereens, soveel mense ondersteun ons en toon respek, integriteit, deernis en eerlikheid, dat die enkeles wat hulle nie hieraan steur nie, nou hul ingesteldheid moet verander.**


